

Dear Parents and Students,

The Gooding School District Student Transportation team is committed to providing our students with safe, quality transportation during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Bus riders are asked to take the following actions to reduce the spread of the virus:

- Students with symptoms are encouraged to stay home.
- Wash or sanitize hands before getting on the bus. School buses are equipped with hand sanitizing stations that students should use when boarding the bus in the afternoons.
- Comply with all Gooding School District face covering mandates. If face coverings are required in school, they are also required on the bus.

New bus procedures:

- Students should maintain physical distance while waiting for the bus at their bus stop and after school. Please contact Student Transportation at 208.934.4321 ext. 3380 if your bus stop location does not permit adequate physical distance.
- Students will load and unload one seat at a time in an orderly manner. The bus driver will direct loading and unloading.
- Buses will be operated with the windows down as conditions allow. Keeping the windows down promotes airflow and reduces the risk for everyone.
