WHAT IS A BOND?

A Bond must be approved by voters and can only be used for capital costs, such as building construction/renovation and vehicle and equipment purchases. The district sells the bonds to investors; uses the bond sale proceeds for construction and capital expenditures; and then pays it back over a specific period of time, (usually 20-30 years) similar to a mortgage. In Idaho a bond requires a two-thirds majority vote for approval.

WHY DO WE NEED TO RUN A BOND?

CURRENT HIGH SCHOOL IS OVER 50 YRS OLD

- SHORT ON CLASSROOM SPACE (*ONE TEACHER WITHOUT CLASSROOM*)
- KITCHEN AND CAFETERIA ARE TOO SMALL
- LOCKER ROOMS ARE IN BASEMENT
 - SAFETY HAZARD & NOT ADA COMPLIANT
- BAND/CHOIR ROOM IS TOO SMALL FOR OUR GROWING PROGRAM
- STUDENT ATHLETES PRACTICE AT 6AM OR STAY UNTIL 8PM TO OBTAIN GYM ACCESS
- MAJORITY OF THE BUILDING DOES NOT HAVE A SPRINKLER SYSTEM

ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL BUILT IN 1995

- SHORT ON CLASSROOM SPACE & STORAGE SPACE (*CLOSETS USED AS CLASSROOMS*)
- FOUR CLASSROOMS IN MODULARS
 - NO RESTROOMS IN MODULARS
 - BACK DOORS ARE LEFT UNLOCKED – CREATING A SAFETY ISSUE
- SPECIAL ED TEACHERS/PARAS SHARE ROOMS WITH SMALL DIVIDERS SEPARATING SPACES
- OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY AND PHYSICAL THERAPY SERVICES ARE HELD IN CLOSETS.
- CAFETERIA OVERCROWDED, DOESN'T ACCOMMODATE ALL STUDENTS AT ONCE
 - LUNCH SERVED 11:00AM-12:30PM
 - (K-8: NEARLY 900 STUDENTS PER DAY)
- MUSIC ROOM TOO SMALL
 - INSTRUMENTS STORED IN HALLWAY
- GES AND GMS KIDS SHARE ONE GYM – AT THE SAME TIME

*The district **already owns** the land.*

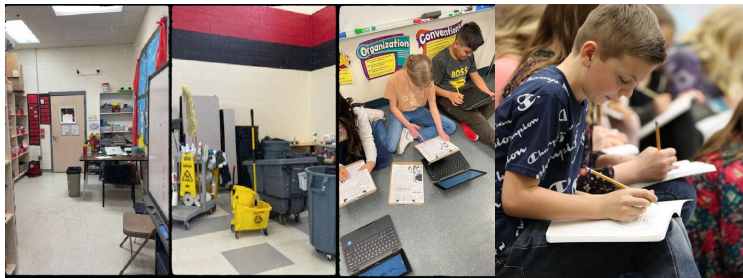
NEW HIGH SCHOOL ADDITIONS \$5 Million

 - Woodshop for middle school students
- Team Rooms (upstairs)
 - Current locker rooms are downstairs
 - Not ADA compliant
- Fire Alarm upgrade & Sprinkler Upgrade
