Free and Reduced Meals

A new application must be submitted every school year. We accept applications beginning July 1st. Applications can be submitted anytime during the school year, however, please be aware that applications are not retroactive and are effective the day of submission. Parents are responsible for the cost of all meals prior to the approval of free or reduced cost meals. Only one application is needed per household. Apply for free or reduced cost meals here.

Managing Your Child's Meal Account

Accounts are **PRE PAID** meal accounts. Parents are responsible of making sure their child has funds available for the purchase of meals. As a courtesy GSD allows accounts to fall in the negative \$22.00. Accounts in the negative are subject to closure.

Titan Family Portal is now **LINQ Connect**. Register <u>here</u> to manage your child's account. Once registered parents are able to add funds and view balances.

Adding Funds to Your Child's Meal Account

Card- Cards can only be used through your account with LINQ Connect. You must be registered with LINQ Connect. To register or access your account visit <u>LINQ Connect</u>.

Cash/Check - Cash or check is still an option for those who choose not to utilize LINQ Connect. However, we do request payment be made at the building's front office and not through the serving line. Cash and check payment can also be made at the district office. Check payments can be mailed to 507 Idaho Street, Gooding, ID 83330.

Breakfast

Students kindergarten - 8th grade: FREE

Students 9th-12th grade with *paid status: \$2.50

Students 9th-12th grade with **reduced status: Free for the 23-24 school year

Adults and visitors: \$3.00.

Seconds are not covered by the free and reduced lunch program and cost \$3.00

Lunch

All students Kindergarten -12th with *paid status: \$3.30.

All students Kindergarten -12th with **reduced status: **FREE** for the 23-24 school year.

Adults and visitors: \$4.75

Seconds are not covered by the free and reduced lunch program and cost \$4.75

Preschool students receive **FREE** breakfast and lunch. **GALC** students receive **FREE** breakfast and lunch.

*paid status= students whose household has completed a free or reduced meal application and student is *not eligible* for free or reduced cost meals or a student whose household has *not completed* a free or reduced meal application.

**reduced status= students whose household has completed a free or reduced meal application and *is eligible* for reduced cost meals

Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP)

Gooding Elementary School proudly participates in the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program. FFVP is a federally assisted program providing free fresh fruits and vegetables to children at eligible elementary schools during the school day at no cost. The goal of the FFVP is to introduce children to fresh fruits and vegetables, to include new and different varieties, and to increase overall acceptance and consumption of fresh, unprocessed produce among children. The FFVP also encourages healthier school environments by promoting nutrition education.

Summer Food Service Program (SFSP)

The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) ensures that children continue to receive nutritious meals when school is not in session. All children 18 years and under, eat free at approved SFSP sites. Help us ensure that no child goes hungry this summer. Participate in the program this summer! Find our Senator StrEat food truck at the West Park, located on California Street (in front of the new playground) or at East Park, located on 3rd & Illinois (by the city pool).
