1st Grade Math

Add and subtract within 20

- Add and subtract within 20
- Knows addition and subtraction facts to 10

Represent and solve problems involving addition and subtraction

- Use addition and subtraction within 20 to solve word problems

Extend the counting sequence

- Count to 120, starting at any number
- Read and write numbers to 120
- Skip count by 2's, 5's and 10's
- Represent a quantity with a written number (example: given some buttons, count and write how many)

Use place value understanding and properties of operations to add and subtract

- Add within 100
- Subtract within 100 (a two-digit number minus a multiple of ten, example 72-30)
- Understand two-digit numbers represent tens and ones

Geometry and Measurement

- Measure objects with different items. (example: measure the length of a table with paperclips)
- Defines attributes and creates 2D/3D shapes
- Tell and write time
- Work with money

Handwriting

- Print legibly.
- Check to make sure the sentence begins with a capital letter, has good spacing between words, and ends with a period, question mark, or exclamation point. Write in complete sentences.

Reading

- Read first grade "Words to Know" without hesitation.
- Read and understand first grade text with ease.
- Retell the most important ideas of what was read.

End of 1st Grade Fluency Goal

- Read 63 words correctly in one minute using grade level text.
- Read with expression, at a conversation rate.
- Self-correct when the reading doesn't look right, sound right, or make sense.

Sumar y restar dentro de 20

- Sumar y restar dentro de 20
- Sumar y restar con fluidez dentro de 10

Representar y resolver problemas de suma y resta

- Usar sumas y restas dentro de 20 para resolver problemas verbales

Extender la secuencia de conteo

- Contar hasta 120, comenzando en cualquier número
- Leer y escribir números hasta 120
- Representar una cantidad con un número escrito (ejemplo: dado algunos botones, contar y escribir cuántos)

Usar la comprensión del valor posicional y las propiedades de las operaciones para sumar y restar

- Sumar dentro de 100
- Restar dentro de 100 (un número de dos dígitos menos un múltiplo de diez, ejemplo 72-30)
- Comprender que los números de dos dígitos representan decenas y unidades.

Geometría y Medición

- Medir objetos con diferentes elementos. (ejemplo: medir el largo de una mesa con clips)
- Definir atributos y crear formas 2D/3D.
- Decir y escribir la hora.
- trabajar con dinero

- Leer 63 palabras correctamente en un minuto usando texto de nivel de grado
- Leer con expresión, a un ritmo de conversación.
- Autocorregir cuando la lectura no se ve bien, no suena bien o no tiene sentido
