Gooding School District Bond Projects

a Gooding High School (Built in 1971)

- New Classrooms: Adds five classrooms to provide needed learning space and restore other areas for storage and office use.
- **Special Education Improvements:** Remodels existing space to create two new classrooms for students needing extra support and therapies.
- **Kitchen Expansion:** Enlarges kitchen and storage areas to meet growing meal service needs as more students eat breakfast and lunch on campus due to the District qualifying for free meals for all students. Currently some food for the high school is prepped at the middle school kitchen and brought to the high school.
- **Multipurpose Room Upgrades:** Replaces worn-out seating and stage curtain. The multipurpose room is used daily for lunch, music and drama productions, testing, and community events.
- CTE (Vo-Ag) Building Updates: Brings intercom, alarm, and fire suppression systems up to code, remodels bathrooms, and updates the HVAC system. About 160 students take cabinetry and agriculture classes here each day.
- **Gym and Locker Room Expansion:** Adds storage, two locker rooms, and two team rooms. Current locker rooms are not ADA compliant and will be repurposed for custodial and maintenance storage.
- Safety and Accessibility Upgrades: Installs updated intercom, alarm, and fire suppression systems. Concessions and restrooms will be accessible from the football field to improve safety and event flow.

Gooding Elementary & Middle School (Built in 1995)

- New Classrooms: Adds 12 classrooms, including four to replace portable fifth-grade rooms that currently pose safety and security challenges.
- **Music and Science Additions:** Builds a second music room so the 100 middle school students don't have to cross the street every day for class and adds a sixth-grade science room.
- **Second Gym:** Adds another gym to reduce crowding and allow more PE and recreation opportunities. Over 800 students use the gym now. The new gym will also be available for Gooding Recreation programs.
- **Multipurpose Room Expansion:** Creates space for daytime instruction and after-school practices such as wrestling and cheerleading.
- **Wood Shop Expansion:** Expands the shop to support increased enrollment, improve safety, and add storage.
- **Science Room Remodel:** Updates seventh- and eighth-grade science rooms with new lab tables and storage.
- **Safety System Upgrades:** Modernizes intercom, alarm, and fire suppression systems throughout the building.
- Parking Lot Paving: Paves the existing gravel parking lot to improve traffic flow and drainage.
